 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the regulation of advertising by structural pest
- 3 control businesses.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1951.206, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1951.206. RULES RESTRICTING ADVERTISING OR
- 8 COMPETITIVE BIDDING. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the
- 9 department may not adopt a rule restricting advertising or
- 10 competitive bidding by a person <u>subject to regulation</u> [<u>regulated</u>]
- 11 by the department under this chapter.
- 12 (b) The department may adopt rules restricting advertising
- 13 or competitive bidding to prohibit false, misleading, or deceptive
- 14 practices by a person subject to regulation [regulated] by the
- 15 department under this chapter. A rule adopted under this
- 16 subsection may not:
- 17 (1) restrict the use of any medium for advertising;
- 18 (2) restrict a person's personal appearance or use of a
- 19 person's voice in an advertisement;
- 20 (3) relate to the size or duration of an advertisement
- 21 by a person; or
- 22 (4) restrict a person's advertisement under a trade
- 23 name.
- (c) Subsection (b)(4) does not prohibit the department from

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- 1 adopting a rule regulating the use of the name of a business or
- 2 <u>license holder in an advertisement for a structural pest control</u>
- 3 <u>business.</u>
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
