A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the regulation of advertising by structural pest 3 control businesses. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 1951.206, Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 1951.206. RULES 7 RESTRICTING ADVERTISING OR COMPETITIVE BIDDING. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the 8 9 department may not adopt a rule restricting advertising or competitive bidding by a person subject to regulation [regulated] 10 11 by the department under this chapter. 12 (b) The department may adopt rules restricting advertising or competitive bidding to prohibit false, misleading, or deceptive 13 practices by a person subject to regulation [regulated] by the 14 department under this chapter. A rule adopted under this 15 16 subsection may not: (1) restrict the use of any medium for advertising; 17 18 restrict a person's personal appearance or use of a (2) person's voice in an advertisement; 19 20 (3) relate to the size or duration of an advertisement 21 by a person; or 22 (4) restrict a person's advertisement under a trade 23 name. 24 (c) Subsection (b)(4) does not prohibit the department from

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<u>adopting a rule regulating the use of the name of a business or</u>
<u>license holder in an advertisement for a structural pest control</u>
<u>business.</u>
SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
