## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 316.002, Government Code, is amended by
5	amending sections (a) and (b) to read as follows:

- 6 (a) Before the Legislative Budget Board submits the budget 7 as prescribed by Section 322.008(c), the board shall establish:
- 8 (1) the estimated rate of growth of the state's economy
  9 from the current biennium to the next biennium and an updated
  10 estimated rate of growth of the state's economy from the previous
  11 biennium through the current biennium;
- 12 (2) the level of appropriations for the current <u>and</u>
  13 <u>previous</u> biennium<u>s</u> from state tax revenues not dedicated by the
  14 constitution; and
- 15 (3) the amount of state tax revenues not dedicated by
  16 the constitution that could be appropriated for the next biennium
  17 within the limit established by the estimated rate of growth of the
  18 state's economy—; and
- (4) the amount of state tax revenues not dedicated by
  the constitution that could be appropriated for the current
  biennium.
- (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), the board shall determine the estimated rate of growth of the state's economy <u>for</u>
  the next biennium by dividing the estimated Texas total personal

- 1 income for the next biennium by the estimated Texas total personal
- 2 income for the current biennium, and for the current biennium by
- 3 <u>dividing the estimated Texas total personal income for the current</u>
- 4 biennium by the estimated Texas total personal income for the
- 5 previous biennium. Using standard statistical methods, the board
- 6 shall make the estimate by projecting through the biennium the
- 7 estimated Texas total personal income reported by the United States
- 8 Department of Commerce or its successor in function.
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
