A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to notice to a surface owner regarding certain oil or gas
- 3 transactions or operations; providing an administrative penalty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter Q, Chapter 91, Natural
- 6 Resources Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER Q. NOTICE OF [PERMIT FOR] CERTAIN OIL AND GAS
- 8 TRANSACTIONS OR OPERATIONS
- 9 SECTION 2. Sections 91.752, 91.753, and 91.754, Natural
- 10 Resources Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 91.752. APPLICABILITY. The provisions of this
- 12 subchapter that relate to the drilling or reentry of an oil or gas
- 13 well apply [This subchapter applies] only to the drilling of a new
- 14 oil or gas well or the reentry of a plugged and abandoned oil or gas
- 15 well. This subchapter does not apply to:
- 16 (1) the plugging back, reworking, sidetracking, or
- 17 deepening of an existing oil or gas well that has not been plugged
- 18 and abandoned; or

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- 19 (2) the use of a surface location that is the site of
- 20 an existing oil or gas well that has not been plugged and abandoned
- 21 to drill a horizontal oil or gas well.
- Sec. 91.753. NOTICE REQUIRED. (a) Not later than the 10th
- 23 day after the date the mineral estate of a tract of land is sold or
- 24 leased, the purchaser or lessee shall give written notice of the

- 1 sale or lease to the surface owner of the tract of land.
- 2 (b) Not later than the 15th business day after the date the
- 3 commission issues an oil or gas well operator a permit to drill a
- 4 new oil or gas well or to reenter a plugged and abandoned oil or gas
- 5 well, the operator shall give written notice of the issuance of the
- 6 permit to the surface owner of the tract of land on which the well is
- 7 located or is proposed to be located.
- 8 <u>(c) An oil or gas well operator shall give written notice to</u>
- 9 the surface owner of a tract of land not later than the 15th day
- 10 before the date the operator begins conducting the following
- 11 operations on the tract of land:
- 12 <u>(1) seismic tests;</u>
- 13 (2) the exploration for or production of oil or gas; or
- 14 (3) the construction of access roads or pipelines or
- other facilities, including well sites or gathering systems.
- 16 (d) A notice under Subsection (c)(3) must include the
- 17 location of the roads or pipelines or other facilities to be
- 18 constructed.
- (e) [(b)] An oil or gas well operator is not required to
- 20 give notice under <u>Subsection (b) or (c)</u> [this subchapter] to a
- 21 surface owner if:
- (1) the operator and the surface owner have entered
- 23 into an agreement that contains alternative provisions regarding
- 24 the operator's obligation to give notice of oil and gas operations;
- 25 or
- 26 (2) the surface owner has waived in writing the owner's
- 27 right to notice under those subsections [this subchapter].

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- Sec. 91.754. ADDRESS FOR NOTICE. Notice under this
- 2 subchapter [The notice] must be given to the surface owner at the
- 3 surface owner's address as shown by the records of the county tax
- 4 assessor-collector at the time the notice is given.
- 5 SECTION 3. Subchapter Q, Chapter 91, Natural Resources
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 91.756 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 91.756. ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY. (a) The commission
- 8 may impose an administrative penalty in the manner provided by
- 9 Sections 81.0531-81.0534 on a person who violates this subchapter.
- 10 The amount of the penalty is equal to \$10,000 for each violation.
- 11 (b) A penalty collected under this section shall be
- 12 deposited to the credit of the oil and gas regulation and cleanup
- 13 fund.
- 14 SECTION 4. Section 91.756, Natural Resources Code, as added
- 15 by this Act, applies only to a violation of Subchapter Q, Chapter
- 16 91, Natural Resources Code, that occurs on or after the effective
- 17 date of this Act. A violation of Subchapter Q, Chapter 91, Natural
- 18 Resources Code, that occurs before the effective date of this Act is
- 19 governed by the law in effect on the date the violation occurred,
- 20 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
