## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

 AN ACT	

- 2 relating to civil liability for promotion of certain improper
- 3 visual images.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Title 4, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Chapter 98B to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 98B. LIABILITY FOR PROMOTION OF IMPROPER VISUAL IMAGE
- 8 Sec. 98B.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "promotion of
- 9 an improper visual image" includes:
- 10 <u>(1) conduct that constitutes an offense under Section</u>
- 11 21.15(b)(3), Penal Code; or
- 12 (2) without a person's consent, the publication or
- 13 promotion of a photograph, videotape recording, or similar visual
- 14 image of the person in the nude or engaged in sexual conduct,
- 15 regardless of whether the person consented to the making of the
- 16 photograph, recording, or image.
- 17 Sec. 98B.002. LIABILITY. A defendant is liable to a victim
- 18 of promotion of an improper visual image, as provided by this
- 19 chapter, for damages arising from the promotion if the defendant:
- 20 (1) knowingly or intentionally engages in promotion of
- 21 an improper visual image with respect to the victim; or
- 22 (2) publishes or promotes an image that the defendant
- 23 knows or reasonably should know constitutes an improper visual
- 24 image under this chapter, and the publication of the image results

- 1 in the promotion of an improper visual image with respect to the
- 2 victim.
- 3 Sec. 98B.003. DAMAGES. (a) A claimant who prevails in a
- 4 suit under this chapter shall be awarded:
- 5 (1) actual damages, including damages for mental
- 6 anguish even if an injury other than mental anguish is not shown;
- 7 (2) court costs; and
- 8 (3) reasonable attorney's fees.
- 9 (b) In addition to an award under Subsection (a), a claimant
- 10 who prevails in a suit under this chapter may recover exemplary
- 11 damages.
- 12 Sec. 98B.004. CAUSE OF ACTION CUMULATIVE. The cause of
- 13 action created by this chapter is cumulative of any other remedy
- 14 provided by common law or statute.
- 15 Sec. 98B.005. JOINT AND SEVERAL LIABILITY. A person who
- 16 engages in conduct described by Section 98B.002 and is found liable
- 17 under this chapter or other law for any amount of damages arising
- 18 from that conduct is jointly and severally liable with any other
- 19 defendant for the entire amount of damages arising from that
- 20 conduct.
- 21 Sec. 98B.006. LIBERAL CONSTRUCTION AND APPLICATION. This
- 22 chapter shall be liberally construed and applied to promote its
- 23 underlying purpose to protect persons from, and provide adequate
- 24 remedies to victims of, promotion of an improper visual image.
- 25 SECTION 2. Chapter 98B, Civil Practice and Remedies Code,
- 26 as added by this Act, applies only to a cause of action that accrues
- 27 on or after the effective date of this Act. A cause of action that

- 1 accrues before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 2 in effect immediately before that date, and that law is continued in
- 3 effect for that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
