- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sec. 552.321, TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE, is amended
- 5 to read as follows
- 6 552.321 SUIT FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS. (a) A requestor or the
- 7 attorney general may file suit for a writ of mandamus compelling a
- 8 governmental body to make information available for public
- 9 inspection if the governmental body refuses to request an attorney
- 10 general's decision as provided by Subchapter G or refuses to supply
- 11 public information or information that the attorney general has
- 12 determined is public information that is not excepted from
- 13 disclosure under Subchapter C.
- 14 (b) A suit filed by a requestor under this section must be
- 15 filed in a district court for the county in which the main offices
- 16 of the governmental body are located. A suit filed by the attorney
- 17 general under this section must be filed in a district court of
- 18 Travis County, except that a suit against a municipality with a
- 19 population of 100,000 or less must be filed in a district court for
- 20 the county in which the main offices of the municipality are
- 21 located.
- (c) Under this section, a governmental body must show proof
- 23 of compliance beyond a verbal or written notice
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
