## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to an individual's responsibilities following an accident
- 3 reasonably likely to result in injury to or death of a person;

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 550.021(a), Transportation Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The operator of a vehicle involved in an accident that
- 9 results or is reasonably likely to result [resulting] in injury to
- 10 or death of a person shall:
- 11 (1) immediately stop the vehicle at the scene of the
- 12 accident or as close to the scene as possible;
- 13 (2) immediately return to the scene of the accident if
- 14 the vehicle is not stopped at the scene of the accident; [and]
- 15 (3) immediately determine whether a person is involved
- 16 in the accident, and if a person is involved in the accident,
- 17 whether that person requires aid; and
- 18  $\underline{(4)}$  remain at the scene of the accident until the
- 19 operator complies with the requirements of Section 550.023.
- 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 21 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 22 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 23 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 24 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For

- 1 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 2 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 3 before that date.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
