- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sec. 545.424, Transportation Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 545.424. OPERATION OF VEHICLE BY PERSON UNDER 18 YEARS
- 8 OF AGE. (a) A person under 18 years of age may not operate a motor
- 9 vehicle while using a wireless communications device, except in
- 10 case of emergency.
- 11 (a-1) A person under 18 years of age may not operate a motor
- 12 vehicle during the 12-month period following issuance of an
- 13 original Class A, B, or C driver's license to the person:
- 14 (1) after midnight and before 5 a.m. unless the
- 15 operation of the vehicle is necessary for the operator to attend or
- 16 participate in employment or a school-related activity or because
- 17 of a medical emergency; or
- 18 (2) with more than one passenger in the vehicle under
- 19 21 years of age who is not a family member.
- 20 (b) A person under 17 years of age who holds a restricted
- 21 motorcycle license or moped license may not operate a motorcycle or
- 22 moped while using a wireless communications device, except in case
- 23 of emergency.
- 24 (b-1) A person under 17 years of age who holds a restricted

- 1 motorcycle license or moped license, during the 12-month period
- 2 following the issuance of an original motorcycle license or moped
- 3 license to the person, may not operate a motorcycle or moped after
- 4 midnight and before 5 a.m. unless:
- 5 (1) the person is in sight of the person's parent or
- 6 guardian; or
- 7 (2) the operation of the vehicle is necessary for the
- 8 operator to attend or participate in employment or a school-related
- 9 activity or because of a medical emergency.
- 10 (c) This section does not apply to:
- 11 (1) the holder of a hardship license;
- 12 (2) a person operating a motor vehicle while
- 13 accompanied in the manner required by Section 521.222(d)(2) for the
- 14 holder of an instruction permit; or
- 15 (3) a person licensed by the Federal Communications
- 16 Commission to operate a wireless communication device or a radio
- 17 frequency device.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
