- 2 relating to a study comparing the compensation of state employees
- 3 to the compensation of private sector employees.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) The comptroller of public accounts, in
- 6 consultation with the state auditor and the Legislative Budget
- 7 Board, shall conduct a study comparing the compensation of state
- 8 employees to the compensation of private sector employees. In
- 9 conducting the study, the comptroller must consider:
- 10 (1) salary and hourly wage compensation provided to
- 11 state employees as compared to salary and hourly wage compensation
- 12 provided to private sector employees whose jobs involve a similar
- 13 level of education and skill; and
- 14 (2) the impact of retirement and health benefit plans
- 15 on the total compensation of both state employees and private
- 16 sector employees.
- 17 (b) The comptroller shall prepare a report of its findings
- 18 from the study. Not later than September 1, 2014, the comptroller
- 19 shall file the report with the governor, the speaker of the house of
- 20 representatives, and the lieutenant governor and make the report
- 21 available on the comptroller's Internet website.
- 22 (c) This Act expires January 1, 2015.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
