- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 101, Insurance Code, is amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 Sec. 101.105. CIVIL PENALTY; INJUNCTIVE RELIEF. (a) A
- 7 person or entity, including an insurer, that violates this chapter
- 8 or Chapter 226 is subject to a civil penalty of not more than
- 9 \$15,000 \$10,000 for each act of violation and for each day of
- 10 violation.
- 11 (b) The commissioner may request that the attorney general
- 12 institute a civil suit in a district court in Travis County for
- 13 injunctive relief to restrain a person or entity, including an
- 14 insurer, from continuing a violation or threat of violation
- 15 described by Section 101.103(a). On application for injunctive
- 16 relief and a finding that a person or entity, including an insurer,
- 17 is violating or threatening to violate this chapter or Chapter 226,
- 18 the district court shall grant the injunctive relief and issue an
- 19 injunction without bond.
- 20 (c) On request by the commissioner, the attorney general
- 21 shall institute and conduct a civil suit in the name of the state
- 22 for injunctive relief, to recover a civil penalty, or for both
- 23 injunctive relief and a civil penalty, as authorized under this
- 24 subchapter.
