- 14 the manufacturer or the manufacturer's designee keeps open and

- 17  $\underline{(2)}$  [ $\overline{(3)}$ ] a system using a collection event held by
- 18 the manufacturer or the manufacturer's designee at which the
- 19 consumer may return computer equipment.
- 20 (d-1) A collection system that allows for the return of
- 21 computer equipment by mail alone does not meet the convenience
- 22 requirements of this section.
- 23 SECTION 2. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality
- 24 shall adopt any rules required to implement the changes in law made
