- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 411.1146(a), Government Code, as added
- 6 by Chapter 870 (S.B. 77), Acts of the 82nd Legislature, Regular
- 7 Session, 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The Department of Agriculture is entitled to obtain
- 9 criminal history record information maintained by the Department of
- 10 Public Safety that relates to a person who is a principal of a
- 11 nongovernmental entity that is a participant in or applicant for
- 12 participation in the Child and Adult Care Food Program or the summer
- 13 <u>food service program</u> as provided by Section 33.0271(e), Human
- 14 Resources Code.
- 15 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 33.0271, Human Resources
- 16 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 33.0271. [CHILD AND ADULT CARE FOOD PROGRAM:] PROGRAM
- 18 PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS: CERTAIN NUTRITIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS.
- 19 SECTION 3. Sections 33.0271(a), (c), (d), (g), and (h),
- 20 Human Resources Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 21 (a) In this section:
- 22 (1) with respect to the Child and Adult Care Food
- 23 Program:
- 24 (A) [7] "institution" has [and "principal" have]

- 1 the meaning [meanings] assigned by 7 C.F.R. Section 226.2; and
- 2 (B) "principal" means any individual who holds a
- 3 management position with, or is an officer of, an institution,
- 4 other than a person whose only role for the institution is serving
- 5 as a member, other than the chair, of the institution's board of
- 6 directors; and
- 7 (2) with respect to the summer food service program:
- 8 (A) "principal" means any individual who holds a
- 9 management position with, or is an officer of, a sponsor, other than
- 10 a person whose only role for the sponsor is serving as a member,
- 11 other than the chair, of the sponsor's board of directors; and
- 12 <u>(B) "sponsor" has the meaning assigned by 7</u>
- 13 C.F.R. Section 225.2.
- 14 (c) To the extent permitted under federal law, on
- 15 application for or renewal of participation in the Child and Adult
- 16 Care Food Program or summer food service program, a nongovernmental
- 17 entity applying to participate or to renew participation in the
- 18 Child and Adult Care Food Program [program] as a sponsoring
- 19 organization or other institution, or in the summer food service
- 20 program as a sponsor, must submit to the department the following
- 21 with respect to each of the entity's principals for use in
- 22 conducting a background and criminal history check:
- 23 (1) a copy of a government-issued form of
- 24 identification of the principal, which may include a copy of:
- 25 (A) a driver's license issued by this state or
- 26 another state;
- 27 (B) an identification card issued by this state,

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- 1 another state, or the federal government;
- 2 (C) a passport; or
- 3 (D) another form of identification approved by
- 4 the department; and
- 5 (2) proof of the principal's residential mailing
- 6 address, which may include:
- 7 (A) official mail sent to the principal's address
- 8 from a utility provider, governmental agency, or financial
- 9 institution;
- 10 (B) a residential lease executed by the
- 11 principal; or
- 12 (C) any other form of proof approved by the
- 13 department.
- 14 (d) If there is a change in a principal or the residential
- 15 mailing address of a principal of a nongovernmental entity
- 16 participating in the Child and Adult Care Food Program as a
- 17 sponsoring organization or other institution, or in the summer food
- 18 service program as a sponsor, the entity must submit to the
- 19 department the same information required under Subsection (c) with
- 20 respect to the principal for use in conducting a background and
- 21 criminal history check.
- 22 (g) If a background and criminal history check authorized
- 23 under Subsection (e) reveals that the principal of an entity that is
- 24 an applicant for or participant in the Child and Adult Care Food
- 25 Program or summer food service program has been convicted of fraud,
- 26 violating an antitrust law, embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery,
- 27 falsification or destruction of records, making false statements,

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- 1 receiving stolen property, making false claims, obstructing
- 2 justice, or any other criminal offense that indicates a lack of
- 3 business integrity as determined by the department, the department:
- 4 (1) shall deny the entity's application for
- 5 participation in the program; or
- 6 (2) may, at the department's discretion, revoke the
- 7 entity's authority to participate in the program.
- 8 (h) The executive commissioner by rule may establish
- 9 procedures that would allow an entity that had the entity's
- 10 application to participate in the Child and Adult Care Food Program
- 11 or summer food service program denied or authority to participate
- 12 in the program revoked under Subsection (g) to appeal the
- 13 department's determination under that subsection.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2014.
