4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 481, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 481.00681 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 481.00681. OFFICE OF SMALL BUSINESS ASSISTANCE
8	ADVISORY TASK FORCE. (a) In this section:
9	(1) "Small business" means a business that employs at
10	least 25 but not more than 250 individuals.
11	(2) "Task force" means the Office of Small Business
12	Assistance Advisory Task Force.
13	(b) The Office of Small Business Assistance shall establish
14	the task force.
15	(c) The task force is composed of seven members appointed as
16	follows:
17	(1) two members appointed by the governor;
18	(2) three members appointed by the speaker of the
19	house of representatives; and
20	(3) two members appointed by the lieutenant governor.
21	(d) A task force member serves a two-year term. A task force
22	member may be reappointed for additional terms.
23	(e) Task force members serve without compensation but are
24	entitled to reimbursement for reasonable and necessary expenses

1	incurred in the discharge of their duties.
2	(f) The task force shall meet as often as necessary but
3	shall meet at least once a year.
4	(g) The task force shall:
5	(1) advise and assist the Office of Small Business
6	Assistance with its duties under Section 481.0068(b) to the extent
7	that they relate to small businesses;
8	(2) advise and assist the governor, the lieutenant
9	governor, and the speaker of the house of representatives with
10	issues that relate to small businesses; and
11	(3) provide information in plain language to the
12	public on issues related to small businesses, including:
13	(A) environmental permitting and compliance;
14	(B) local regulations;
15	(C) construction permitting;
16	(D) the duties of the comptroller to the extent
17	that the duties relate to small businesses; and
18	(E) the formation of business entities.
19	(h) Not later than January 1 of each odd-numbered year, the
20	task force shall submit to the legislature a report that:
21	(1) describes issues related to small businesses; and
22	(2) proposes legislation to assist small businesses.
23	SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
24	of this Act, the governor, the lieutenant governor, and the speaker
25	of the house of representatives shall appoint the members of the
26	Office of Small Business Assistance Advisory Task Force as required
27	by Section 481.00681, Government Code, as added by this Act.

1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
