5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 46, Education Code, is

6 amended by adding Section 46.062 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 46.062. STATE-FACILITATED MECHANISM FOR REFINANCING.

8 (a) To the extent authorized by law, the commissioner, attorney

9 general, and executive director of the Texas Public Finance

10 Authority shall develop and implement mechanisms to assist school

11 districts in refinancing school district debt.

12 (b) If the commissioner, attorney general, and executive

director of the Texas Public Finance Authority determine that

insufficient legal authority exists to permit implementation of an

15 effective mechanism for the state to assist in refinancing of

16 school district debt, the commissioner, attorney general, and

17 executive director shall develop specific recommendations for

18 statutory changes that would permit implementation of an effective

19 <u>mechanism</u>.

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20 <u>(c) In performing the duties imposed by this section, the</u>

21 commissioner, attorney general, and executive director of the Texas

22 Public Finance Authority shall seek input from members of the

23 public with expertise regarding school district and state financing

24 mechanisms.

- 1 (d) Not later than September 1, 2014, the commissioner,
- 2 attorney general, and executive director of the Texas Public
- 3 Finance Authority shall submit a joint report to the governor,
- 4 lieutenant governor, and members of the legislature that identifies
- 5 any mechanisms developed and implemented under Subsection (a) and
- 6 any recommendations for statutory changes developed under
- 7 <u>Subsection (b).</u>
- 8 <u>(e) This section expires September 1, 2015.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
