A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to participation by certain students with disabilities in
3	extracurricular athletic activities sponsored or sanctioned by a
4	school district.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 33.0813 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 33.0813. PARTICIPATION BY STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES
9	IN SCHOOL DISTRICT EXTRACURRICULAR ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES. (a) In
10	this section, an individual is a qualified individual with a
11	disability if the individual meets the criteria as a qualified
12	individual with a disability under Section 504, Rehabilitation Act
13	of 1973 (29 U.S.C. Section 794), and regulations adopted under that
14	law.
15	(b) In accordance with Section 504, Rehabilitation Act of
16	1973 (29 U.S.C. Section 794), and regulations adopted under that
17	law, each school district shall provide to a district student who is
18	a qualified individual with a disability the opportunity to benefit
19	from an extracurricular athletic activity sponsored or sanctioned
20	by the district equal to the opportunity provided by the district to
21	a student without a disability.
22	(c) In carrying out Subsection (b), a school district shall

make reasonable modifications and provide those aids and services

that are necessary to ensure that a district student who is a

- 1 qualified individual with a disability participates with students
- 2 without disabilities in an extracurricular athletic activity
- 3 sponsored or sanctioned by the district to the maximum extent
- 4 appropriate to the needs of the qualified individual with a
- 5 disability, except that the district may:
- 6 (1) require a level of skill or ability as a
- 7 qualification for participation in a competitive extracurricular
- 8 activity;
- 9 (2) refrain from taking measures that would
- 10 fundamentally alter the nature of the extracurricular activity; and
- 11 (3) adopt bona fide safety standards.
- 12 (d) If a district student who is a qualified individual
- 13 with a disability is unable, even with reasonable modifications or
- 14 aids and services, to participate with students without
- 15 <u>disabilities in an extracurricular athletic activity sponsored or</u>
- 16 sanctioned by the district, a district shall, to the greatest
- 17 extent practicable:
- 18 (1) provide opportunities for the student to
- 19 participate in separate or different extracurricular athletic
- 20 activities with other students with disabilities; and
- 21 (2) support those activities to the same extent that
- 22 <u>the district supports other extracurricular athletic activities.</u>
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
