- 2 Sec. 388.009. RESIDENTIAL AIR LEAKAGE AND DUCT TIGHTNESS
- 3 TESTING. (a) A person with an approved certification is considered
- 4 an approved party for purposes of performing air leakage and duct
- 5 tightness testing to ensure compliance with the International
- 6 Residential Code or the International Energy Conservation Code.
- 7 (b) A person performing air leakage and duct tightness
- 8 testing must be independent from the installer of the product being
- 9 testing.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect on September 1, 2013.
