- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 61.036, Health and Safety Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 6 (d) Regardless of the application, documentation, and
- 7 verification procedures or eligibility standards established by
- 8 the department under Subchapter A, a county may credit an
- 9 <u>intergovernmental transfer to the state toward eligibility for</u>
- 10 state assistance if the transfer was made to provide health care
- 11 services as part of a waiver program under 42 U.S.C. Section 1315 or
- 12 42 U.S.C. Section 1396n.
- SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 14 only to state assistance for health care services under Chapter 61,
- 15 Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act, that are delivered
- 16 on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 (b) State assistance for health care services under Chapter
- 18 61, Health and Safety Code, that are delivered before the effective
- 19 date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed immediately
- 20 before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in
- 21 effect for that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
