- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 775, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 775.0821 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 775.0821. ALTERNATIVE TO AUDIT OF DISTRICT IN LESS
- 8 POPULOUS COUNTIES. (a) This section applies only to a district to
- 9 which Section 775.082 applies that:
- 10 (1) did not have any outstanding bonds or any
- 11 outstanding liabilities having a term of more than one year during
- 12 the previous fiscal year;
- 13 (2) did not receive more than a total of \$250,000 in
- 14 gross receipts from operations, loans, taxes, or contributions
- 15 during the previous fiscal year; and
- 16 (3) did not have a total of more than \$250,000 in cash
- 17 and temporary investments during the previous fiscal year.
- 18 (b) Instead of filing an audit report under Section 775.082,
- 19 a district to which this section applies may submit an annual
- 20 financial report to the commissioners court of each county in which
- 21 any part of the district is located.
- (c) The district must submit with the financial report an
- 23 <u>affidavit signed by an authorized district representative</u>
- 24 attesting to the accuracy and authenticity of the report.

- 1 (d) The county auditor, with the approval of the
- 2 commissioners court, shall adopt rules relating to the format of
- 3 the financial report and affidavit. If a district is located in
- 4 more than one county, the county auditors, with the approval of the
- 5 commissioners court of each county in which the district is
- 6 located, shall adopt uniform rules relating to the format of the
- 7 <u>financial report and affidavit.</u>
- 8 <u>(e) The provisions of Section 775.082 relating to deadlines</u>
- 9 for filing an audit and the procedures and penalties relating to the
- 10 failure of a district to file an audit apply to the filing of a
- 11 financial statement under this section.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
