## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the determination of an applicant's eligibility for any
- 3 program administered by the Health and Human Services Commission.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 521.044, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsections (a) and (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Information provided on a driver's license application
- 8 that relates to the applicant's social security number may be used
- 9 only by the department or disclosed only to:
- 10 (1) the child support enforcement division of the
- 11 attorney general's office;
- 12 (2) another state entity responsible for enforcing the
- 13 payment of child support;
- 14 (3) the United States Selective Service System as
- 15 provided by Section 521.147; [or]
- 16 (4) the unclaimed property division of the
- 17 comptroller's office; or
- 18 (5) the Health and Human Services Commission.
- 19 (c)(1) On the request of a state entity responsible for
- 20 investigating or enforcing the payment of child support, the
- 21 department shall disclose information regarding an applicant's
- 22 social security number.
- (c)(2) On the request of the Health and Human Services
- 24 Commission and for the purpose of assisting the commission in

- 1 determining an applicant's eligibility for any program
- 2 administered by the commission, the department shall disclose
- 3 <u>information regarding an applicant's social security number.</u>
- 4 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 5 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 6 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 7 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 8 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 9 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
