A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to ad valorem taxes assessed by an emergency services
- 3 district; removing the debt service component of the ad valorem tax
- 4 rate from the computation of the maximum tax rate.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 775.018(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) On the granting of a petition, the commissioners court
- 9 shall order an election to confirm the district's creation and
- 10 authorize the imposition of an ad valorem [a] tax [not to exceed the
- 11 rate allowed by Section 48-e, Article III, Texas
- 12 Constitution]. Any conditions negotiated under Section 775.014(h)
- 13 must be included on the ballot.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 775.074, Health and Safety Code, is
- 15 amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 16 <u>(f) The board may not establish a maintenance and operations</u>
- 17 tax rate that exceeds 10 cents on each \$100 valuation of taxable
- 18 property in the district. A reference in this chapter to a maximum
- 19 ad valorem tax rate means the maximum rate prescribed by this
- 20 <u>subsection</u>.
- 21 SECTION 3. Section 775.0745(a), Health and Safety Code is
- 22 amended to read as follows:
- 23 (a) If the board decides to increase the maximum tax rate of
- 24 the district to any rate at or below the rate allowed by this

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- 1 chapter [or Section 48-e, Article III, Texas Constitution], the
- 2 board must order an election to authorize the increase. The
- 3 proposition on the ballot must state the proposed maximum tax rate
- 4 to be authorized at the election.
- 5 SECTION 4. (a) This Act takes effect only if the
- 6 constitutional amendment proposed by the 83rd Legislature, Regular
- 7 Session, 2013, clarifying the authority of emergency services
- 8 districts to levy taxes and issue bonds or other obligations and
- 9 removing the limitation on the ad valorem tax rate takes effect. If
- 10 that amendment is not approved by the voters, this Act has no
- 11 effect.
- 12 (b) This Act takes effect on the date on which the
- 13 constitutional amendment described by Subsection (a) of this
- 14 section takes effect.
