- "Intoxicants and Narcotics: The insurer is not liable for

- 15 narcotic is administered on the advice of a physician."
- 16 (b) An individual accident and health insurance policy that
- 17 provides coverage for medical, hospital, and surgical expenses
- 18 incurred by an insured may not contain the provision described by
- 19 Subsection (a) unless the insurer provides notice to the insured of
- 20 the provision and gives the insured an option to purchase a rider or
- 21 endorsement that provides coverage for any loss sustained or

- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an individual accident and health insurance policy that is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2014. An individual accident and health insurance policy that is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2014,
- 6 is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the
- 7 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 8 that purpose.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
