## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to certain limitations in health benefit plans and health
- 3 insurance policies.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1201.227, Insurance Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1201.227. POLICY PROVISION: INTOXICANTS AND
- 8 NARCOTICS. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), an [An]
- 9 individual accident and health insurance policy must contain the
- 10 following provision if the policy addresses the subject matter of
- 11 the provision:
- "Intoxicants and Narcotics: The insurer is not liable for
- 13 any loss sustained or contracted in consequence of the insured's
- 14 being intoxicated or under the influence of any narcotic unless the
- 15 narcotic is administered on the advice of a physician."
- 16 (b) An individual accident and health insurance policy may
- 17 not contain the provision described by Subsection (a) unless the
- 18 insured is given notice of such policy and an option to opt out of
- 19 Subsection (a). An insured may purchase an optional rider to
- 20 provide coverage such that the insurer is liable for any loss
- 21 sustained or contracted in consequence of the insured's being
- 22 intoxicated or under the influence of any narcotic if the narcotic
- 23 is not administered on the advice of a physician.
- 24 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only

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- 1 to a health benefit plan that is delivered, issued for delivery, or
- 2 renewed on or after January 1, 2014. A health benefit plan that is
- 3 delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2014,
- 4 is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective
- 5 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 6 purpose.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
