The department shall issue a Class M 13 14 license that is restricted to the operation of a three-wheeled motorcycle if the motorcycle operator training course completed by 15 16 the applicant is specific to the operation of a three-wheeled 17 motorcycle. 18 SECTION 3. Section 545.416(b), Transportation Code, amended to read as follows: 19 An operator may not carry another person on 20 21 motorcycle, and a person who is not operating the motorcycle may not

- 11 (1) shall contain information regarding operating a
- 12 motorcycle while carrying a passenger; and
- 13 (2) may [shall] include curricula developed by the
- 14 Motorcycle Safety Foundation.
- 15 SECTION 6. Section 662.006, Transportation Code, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 662.006. UNAUTHORIZED TRAINING PROHIBITED. (a) A
- 18 person may not offer or conduct training in motorcycle operation
- 19 for [a] consideration unless the person is licensed by or contracts
- 20 with the designated state agency.
- 21 (b) A person who violates Subsection (a) commits an offense.
- 22 An offense under this subsection is a Class B misdemeanor, except
- 23 that the offense is a Class A misdemeanor if it is shown on the trial
- 24 of the offense that the defendant has been previously convicted of
- 25 an offense under this section.
- SECTION 7. Section 662.008(b), Transportation Code, is
- 27 amended to read as follows:

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- 1 (b) Following denial, suspension, or cancellation of
- 2 [Before the designated state agency may deny, suspend, or cancel]
- 3 the approval of a program sponsor or an instructor, notice and
- 4 opportunity for a hearing must be given as provided by:
- 5 (1) Chapter 2001, Government Code; and
- 6 (2) Chapter 53, Occupations Code.
- 7 SECTION 8. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 8 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 9 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 10 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 11 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 12 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 13 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 14 before that date.
- 15 SECTION 9. Except as otherwise provided by this Act, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
