4	SECTION 1. Chapter 29, Education Code, is amended by adding

11	Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. Section 6301 et seq.).
12	Sec. 29.602. NOTIFICATION OF STUDENT ELIGIBILITY. (a) The
13	agency shall notify a school district of students enrolled in the
14	district who are eligible for services under the program.
15	(b) Each school district shall notify the parents of ar
16	eligible student of the availability of the services and provide
17	the parents with information regarding the applicable procedures
18	for applying to enroll the student in the program.

Sec. 29.603. ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES. (a) The agency shall

- 4 Sec. 29.604. TUTORING PROVIDERS. (a) A student may receive
- 5 supplemental educational services under the program only through a
- 6 tutoring provider that:
- 7 (1) is certified for that purpose by the agency; and
- 8 (2) enters into a contract with the district and the
- 9 agency governing the provision of those services.
- 10 (b) The agency shall adopt a statewide uniform contract for
- 11 purposes of Subsection (a)(2).
- 12 (c) The agency shall set reimbursement rates for tutoring
- 13 providers. Each tutoring provider shall submit invoices for
- 14 services directly to the agency.
- 15 (d) The agency shall notify a school district and the
- 16 parents of a child receiving services from a tutoring provider if
- 17 the tutoring provider becomes ineligible to provide services under
- 18 the program.
- 19 Sec. 29.605. FUNDING. (a) The agency shall fund the
- 20 program by retaining, for each school district with students
- 21 eligible for services under the program, a portion of the federal
- 22 funding under <u>Title I of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act</u>
- 23 of 1965 (20 U.S.C. Section 6301 et seq.) that would otherwise be
- 24 provided directly to the district.
- 25 (b) The amount retained under Subsection (a) may not exceed
- 26 the amount that the school district could be required to use for
- 27 supplemental educational services under federal law in the absence

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- 1 of any applicable federal waiver. The agency shall determine the
- 2 amount to retain for each school district based on the estimated
- 3 number of students in the district eligible for services under the

- 5 (c) Any portion of funds retained for a school district that
- 6 is not used to pay the costs of providing supplemental educational
- 7 <u>services to eligible students in the district shall be released to</u>

- 9 Sec. 29.606. INCENTIVES FOR EFFECTIVE USE OF PROGRAM. (a)
- 10 The agency shall make efforts to provide incentives to school
- 11 districts to achieve improvements in academic achievement through
- 12 effective use of supplemental educational services provided under
- 13 the program.
- 14 (b) In making discretionary grants to school districts
- 15 under any provision of this code, the agency may give a preference
- 16 to a school district that demonstrates effective use of
- 17 supplemental educational services provided under the program.
- 18 Sec. 29.607. RULES. The commissioner shall adopt rules
- 19 necessary to implement this subchapter.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
