 9 tariff or rate schedule in which a nonfuel rate may be periodically
 10 adjusted upward or downward, based on changes in the parts of the
 11 utility's invested capital that serves the utility's certificated
- 12 service area, including a facility used for:
- (1) the production, transmission, storage,

 14 distribution, or provision of potable or recycled water to the

 15 public; or
- 16 (2) the collection, transportation, treatment,
 17 or disposal of sewage.
- 18 <u>(b) The utility commission shall adopt rules as necessary to</u>
 19 <u>implement Section 13.193. modeled on rules implementing Section</u>
 20 36.210, Utilities Code by September 1, 2015 providing that:

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1	(1) the utility's revenue may not increase or
2	decrease by more than five percent,
3	(2) the facilities described in the petition have
4	been placed into service by the utility,
5	(3) the return on invested capital, depreciation
6	rate, and income tax rate is up to the amount
7	authorized in the utility's most recent rate
8	order,
9	(4) does not include the operating expenses
10	associated with the facilities described
11	in the petition,
12	(5) the utility has not filed a petition
13	authorized by this section in the prior
14	twelve months,
15	(6) the utility has not filed four petitions
16	authorized by this section since the utility's
17	last general rate application filed under
18	Section 13.187(a).
