- 2 relating to the dissolution of the Lipan Creek Flood Control
- 3 District.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. On the effective date of this Act:
- 6 (1) the Lipan Creek Flood Control District is
- 7 dissolved;
- 8 (2) the terms of the directors of the district expire;
- 9 and
- 10 (3) any assets of the district, including any tax or
- 11 assessment revenue, that remain after payment of the district's
- 12 liabilities are transferred to Concho and Tom Green Counties, in
- 13 the proportion that the area of each county located in the territory
- 14 of the district bears to the total area of the district.
- 15 SECTION 2. The following laws are repealed:
- 16 (1) Chapter 628, Acts of the 59th Legislature, Regular
- 17 Session, 1965; and
- 18 (2) Chapter 473, Acts of the 67th Legislature, Regular
- 19 Session, 1981.
- 20 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 21 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 22 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 23 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 24 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished

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- 1 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 2 Government Code.
- 3 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 4 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 5 Environmental Quality.
- 6 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 7 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 8 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 9 representatives within the required time.
- 10 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 11 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 12 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 13 and accomplished.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
