BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 1-19 SECTION 1. On the effective date of this Act: (1) the 1-20 Lipan Creek Flood Control District is 1-21 dissolved; 1-22 1-23 the terms of the directors of the district expire; (2) and 1-24 any assets of the district, including any tax or (3) 1-25 assessment revenue, that remain after payment of the district's 1-26 liabilities are transferred to Concho and Tom Green Counties, in 1-27 1-28 the proportion that the area of each county located in the territory of the district bears to the total area of the district. SECTION 2.
