1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the board of directors of the Tarrant Regional Water  
 1-22 District.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Chapter 268, Acts of the 55th Legislature,  
 1-25 Regular Session, 1957, is amended by adding Section 1A to read as  
 1-26 follows:

1-27 Sec. 1A. (a) The district shall be governed by a board of  
 1-28 five elected directors.

1-29 (b) Directors serve staggered four-year terms and until  
 1-30 their successors have qualified.

1-31 (c) On the uniform election date in May of each odd-numbered  
 1-32 year, the appropriate number of directors shall be elected.

1-33 SECTION 2. (a) The legal notice of the intention to  
 1-34 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this  
 1-35 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a  
 1-36 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,  
 1-37 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished  
 1-38 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,  
 1-39 Government Code.

1-40 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has  
 1-41 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on  
 1-42 Environmental Quality.

1-43 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed  
 1-44 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the  
 1-45 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of  
 1-46 representatives within the required time.

1-47 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this  
 1-48 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect  
 1-49 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled  
 1-50 and accomplished.

1-51 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-52 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-53 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-54 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-55 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
