## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

relating to the boundaries of the East Montgomery County Municipal Utility Districts Nos. 6 and 7.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Section 2, Chapter 775, Acts of the 79th Legislature, Regular Session, 2005, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2. (a) The [Each district initially includes, respectively, the texicory contained in the following axeas as indicated:

SECTION 2. The East Montgomery County Municipal Utility Districts Nos. 6 and 7 retain all rights, powers, privileges, authority, duties, and functions that they had before the effective date of this Act. Notwithstanding any other law, the East Montgomery County Municipal Utility Districts Nos. 6 and 7 may continue to rely on any bond election held before the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. (a) The legislature validates and confirms all governmental acts and proceedings, including an election, of the

East Montgomery County Municipal Utility Districts Nos. 6 and 7 that were taken before the effective date of this Act.
(b) This section does not apply to:
(1) an act, proceeding, director, other official, bond, or other obligation the validity of which or of whom is the subject of litigation that is pending on the effective date of this Act; or
(2) an act or proceeding that, under a statute of this state or the United States, was a misdemeanor or felony at the time the act or proceeding occurred.

SECTION 4. The amendments made by this Act to Section 2, Chapter 775, Acts of the 79th Legislature, Regular Session, 2005, do not alter or otherwise affect the boundaries of the district territory of the East Montgomery County Municipal Utility District No. 5.

SECTION 5. (a) The legal notice of the intention to introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, Government Code.
(b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
(c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
(d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled and accomplished.

SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
