H.B. No. 3933

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the transfer of territory, assets, liabilities, and
- 3 duties of the former Cuadrilla Improvement Corporation to the Lower
- 4 Valley Water District.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. In this Act:
- 7 (1) "Commission" means the Texas Commission on
- 8 Environmental Quality or, as appropriate, its predecessor, the
- 9 Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission.
- 10 (2) "Corporation" means the Cuadrilla Improvement
- 11 Corporation.
- 12 (3) "Authority" means the Lower Valley Water District.
- SECTION 2. FINDINGS. (a) On July 8, 1992, the County of El
- 14 Paso, Texas, by and through the county judge of El Paso County,
- 15 quitclaimed the county's right, title, and interest in and to the
- 16 property and any improvements to the property described by Section
- 17 3 of this Act, to the corporation by executing a quitclaim deed,
- 18 record number 009280, as recorded in the county records of El Paso
- 19 County.
- 20 (b) The El Paso Water Control and Improvement District No. 4
- 21 assumed the responsibilities as temporary manager of the
- 22 corporation, including the provision of water and wastewater
- 23 services to customers of the corporation by emergency order issued
- 24 by the commission on September 30, 1999, and confirmed by the

- 1 commission on October 27, 1999.
- 2 (c) The corporation was involuntarily dissolved by order of
- 3 the secretary of state on July 18, 2007.
- 4 (d) The El Paso Water Control and Improvement District No. 4
- 5 no longer wishes to continue providing service to the former
- 6 corporation's customers, and the authority is willing to provide
- 7 and capable of providing that service and of assuming any other
- 8 duties of the former corporation, provided that the authority is
- 9 granted any remaining assets of the former corporation, including
- 10 the real property and any improvements to the property described by
- 11 Section 3 of this Act.
- 12 (e) The transfer of any remaining assets of the former
- 13 corporation, including the real property and any improvements to
- 14 the property described by Section 3 of this Act, serves a public
- 15 purpose and benefits the land included in the transfer.
- SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 2, Chapter 780, Acts of the
- 17 69th Legislature, Regular Session, 1985, is amended by adding
- 18 Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 19 (c) In addition to the territory described by Subsection (a)
- 20 of this section, the authority includes all of the property and any
- 21 improvements to the property contained in the following area:
- 22 Property (including any improvements):
- 23 <u>Parcel No. 1 Description</u>
- 24 Being a 0.245 acre parcel of land out of Tract 2C, Block 40, San
- 25 Elizario Grant in El Paso County, Texas and being more particularly
- 26 described by metes and bounds as follows to wit:
- 27 Beginning at the most Westerly corner of said Tract 2C, Block 40,

- 1 San Elizario Grant;
- 2 Thence, along the common line of said Tract 2C and the Cuadrilla
- 3 Lateral, North 70° 24' East, 80.79 feet to a point for corner;
- 4 Thence, continuing along said common line of said Tract 2C and the
- 5 Cuadrilla Lateral, North 63° 40' East, 167.05 feet to a point for
- 6 corner;
- 7 Thence, South 30° 16' East, 59.35 feet to a point for corner;
- 8 Thence, South 61° 24' West, 106.11 feet to a point for corner;
- 9 Thence, North 89° 42' West, 162.58 feet to the point of beginning and
- 10 containing 10,678.95 square feet or 0.245 acres of land more or
- 11 less.
- 12 Parcel No. 2 Description
- 13 Being a 1.355 acre parcel of land out of Tract 11-A, Block 5, San
- 14 Elizario Grant in El Paso County, Texas and being more particularly
- 15 <u>described by metes and bounds as follows, to wit:</u>
- 16 Beginning at the Northwesterly corner of said Tract 11-A, Block 5,
- 17 San Elizario Grant, said point also being on the East right-of-way
- 18 line of San Francisco Street as shown on the Cuadrilla Townsite map;
- 19 Thence, along the South line of the Cuadrilla Lateral, North 49° 34'
- 20 East, 8.30 feet to a point for corner;
- 21 Thence, South 89° 42' East, 235.80 feet to a point for corner;
- 22 Thence, North 61° 24' East, 106.11 feet to a point for corner;
- 23 Thence, South 30° 16' East, 127.00 feet to a point on the North
- 24 right-of-way line of the Cuadrilla Cut-Off Road;
- 25 Thence along the North right-of-way line of the Cuadrilla Cut-Off
- 26 Road, South 59° 44' West, 355.59 feet to the point for corner;
- 27 Thence, North 21° 30' West, 251.47 feet to the point of beginning and

- 1 containing 59,017.08 square feet or 1.355 acres of land more or
- 2 less.
- 3 SECTION 4. TRANSFER OF ASSETS AND RESPONSIBILITIES. On the
- 4 effective date of this Act, the authority shall assume:
- 5 (1) from the El Paso Water Control and Improvement
- 6 District No. 4, the responsibility of providing water and
- 7 wastewater services to the customers in the service area of the
- 8 former corporation; and
- 9 (2) the powers, duties, liabilities, and remaining
- 10 assets of the former corporation, including the property described
- 11 by Section 3 of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 5. FINDINGS RELATED TO PROCEDURAL REQUIREMENTS.
- 13 (a) The legal notice of the intention to introduce this Act,
- 14 setting forth the general substance of this Act, has been published
- 15 as provided by law, and the notice and a copy of this Act have been
- 16 furnished to all persons, agencies, officials, or entities to which
- 17 they are required to be furnished under Section 59, Article XVI,
- 18 Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, Government Code.
- 19 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 20 submitted the notice and Act to the commission.
- 21 (c) The commission has filed its recommendations relating
- 22 to this Act with the governor, the lieutenant governor, and the
- 23 speaker of the house of representatives within the required time.
- 24 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 25 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 26 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 27 and accomplished.

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- 1 SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 2 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 3 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 4 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 5 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
