

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1           WHEREAS, Words cannot express the sorrow felt at the loss of  
2 Michael Gilles Purgason of Arlington, who died on July 13, 2012, at  
3 the age of 21; and

4           WHEREAS, Michael Purgason was born in Arlington on December  
5 28, 1990, to Thomas and Michele Purgason; he attended Mansfield  
6 Summit High School, where he served on the student council and  
7 helped found the Republican Club; an excellent athlete, he played  
8 baseball and basketball and managed the girls' volleyball team; he  
9 graduated summa cum laude in 2009; and

10           WHEREAS, Mr. Purgason went on to attend The University of  
11 Texas at Austin, where he majored in English and biology;  
12 passionate about volleyball, he was a mainstay of the UT Men's Club  
13 Volleyball team, serving as president during the 2011-2012 school  
14 year; he was also an enthusiastic supporter of the athletic  
15 activities of his brother, Nicholas, and his sister, Ashley, and of  
16 the Lady Longhorns volleyball team; and

17           WHEREAS, Following in the family tradition of his father,  
18 grandfather, great-grandfather, and uncle, Mr. Purgason sought a  
19 career in medicine as a means to express his compassion for others  
20 and his deep religious faith, and he had recently applied to medical  
21 school with the intention of becoming a primary care physician; at  
22 the time of his death, he was already conducting biomedical  
23 research at The University of Texas Medical Branch in Galveston;

1           WHEREAS, Known affectionately as "Purgy," this gifted and  
2 charismatic young man was a devoted son, a loving brother, and a  
3 fiercely loyal friend, and the memory of his generosity toward  
4 others, keen intelligence, and joie de vivre will continue to  
5 inspire all those who knew and loved him; now, therefore, be it

6           RESOLVED, That the 83rd Legislature of the State of Texas  
7 hereby pay tribute to the life of Michael Gilles Purgason and extend  
8 sincere condolences to the members of his family: to his parents,  
9 Thomas and Michele Purgason; to his brother, Nicholas Purgason; to  
10 his sister, Ashley Purgason; to his grandmother, Doris Purgason;  
11 and to his other relatives and many friends; and, be it further
