CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Municipal governments contribute immeasurably to 2 the quality of life of residents throughout Texas; no other level of government is more accountable and responsive on a daily basis; and 3 WHEREAS, Local police and fire departments safeguard lives 4 and public health officials promote the well-being of area 5 citizens; cities also ensure the collection and disposal of 6 7 garbage, provide safe, clean, and reliable drinking water, maintain a wastewater infrastructure, and oversee sidewalk and street 8 9 maintenance; and

10 WHEREAS, Among the many other vital functions of municipal 11 government are the provision of schools for young people and the 12 development and support of public parks and libraries; and

WHEREAS, Engines of economic development, cities create opportunities for businesses and provide the infrastructure for those businesses to succeed; and
