CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The Rotary Club of Austin is celebrating its 100th 2 anniversary on April 6, 2013, and this occasion offers a welcome 3 opportunity to honor the organization and its many good works; and

WHEREAS, Founded in 1913, the Rotary Club of Austin was formed to bring together business, professional, and social leaders for the purposes of serving others and fostering self-improvement among members; the club encourages high ethical standards, humanitarian service, and volunteerism, and gives back in a number of ways; and

10 WHEREAS, With approximately 300 members, the Rotary Club of 11 Austin is the largest of the 13 Rotary Clubs in the capital area; it 12 is also the oldest of Austin's clubs; its members contribute to the 13 initiatives of the Rotary International organization, such as its 14 efforts to promote literacy and to improve world health and 15 eradicate polio, as well as to local causes; and

16 WHEREAS, The club's first and longest-standing service has been providing support to the Helping Hand Home for Children; 17 moreover, the club organizes Camp Enterprise, a weekend camp for 18 high school students that encourages young people to develop and 19 propose their own business plans; it also sponsors Fulmore Middle 20 21 School and Dawson and Pecan Springs Elementary Schools, donating books, mentoring students, and teaching character building and 22 23 ethics; in addition, the club organizes a citywide project known as Service Austin for disadvantaged citizens and makes numerous 24

1 scholarships available to deserving students; and

2 WHEREAS, The club's international work includes Group Study 3 Exchanges with foreign countries to establish world understanding 4 and a special service to military personnel known as Operation 5 Vacation Rest and Relaxation, which assists in reconnecting 6 families when troops return home, as well as many other projects; 7 and

8 WHEREAS, For the past century, members of the Rotary Club of 9 Austin have performed works of lasting benefit to the local 10 community and beyond, and the group's noteworthy achievements are a 11 tribute to the dedication of its members, both past and present; 12 now, therefore, be it

13 RESOLVED, That the 83rd Legislature of the State of Texas 14 hereby commemorate the 100th anniversary of the Rotary Club of 15 Austin and extend to its members sincere best wishes for continued 16 success with their important work; and, be it further

17 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be 18 prepared for the club as an expression of high regard by the Texas 19 House of Representatives and Senate.
