- 3 WHEREAS, Wait times result in a reduction in commercial and
- 4 economic activity; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Wait times produce a significant increase of
- 6 negative environmental impacts in the state; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Although Texas is a leader in trade relations in the
- 8 international marketplace, eradication of wait times at points of
- 9 entry would tremendously benefit the state, and every means of
- 10 combating it should be explored; now, therefore, be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the 83rd Legislature of the State of Texas,
- 12 hereby request the lieutenant governor and the speaker of the house
- 13 of representatives to create a joint interim committee to study the
- 14 effects on international trade on wait times at points of entry
- 15 between the United States and the United Mexican States; and be it
- 16 further
- 17 RESOLVED, That the committee submit a full report including
- 18 findings and recommendations, to the 84th Texas Legislature when it
- 19 convenes in January, 2015.
