HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Wait times at points of entry between the United
2 States and the United Mexican States are considerable; and

3 WHEREAS, Wait times result in a reduction in commercial and
4 economic activity; and

5 WHEREAS, Wait times produce a significant increase of
6 negative environmental impacts in the state; and

7 WHEREAS, Although Texas is a leader in trade relations in the
8 international marketplace, eradication of wait times at points of
9 entry would tremendously benefit the state, and every means of
10 combating it should be explored; now, therefore, be it

11 RESOLVED, That the 83rd Legislature of the State of Texas,
12 hereby request the lieutenant governor and the speaker of the house
13 of representatives to create a joint interim committee to study the
14 effects on international trade on wait times at points of entry
15 between the United States and the United Mexican States; and be it
16 further

17 RESOLVED, That the committee submit a full report including
18 findings and recommendations, to the 84th Texas Legislature when it
19 convenes in January, 2015.
