## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, George P. Mitchell is being honored with a
- 2 History-Making Texan Award by the Texas State History Museum
- 3 Foundation on February 27, 2013, in tribute to his exemplary
- 4 contributions to the oil and gas industry; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The History-Making Texan Award is given annually to
- 6 those Texans who have made an extraordinary impact on the state and
- 7 nation; among the recipients of this accolade are former U.S.
- 8 presidents and state governors, as well as renowned business
- 9 leaders, scientists, entertainers, and media figures; and
- 10 WHEREAS, A native of Galveston, Mr. Mitchell graduated from
- 11 Texas A&M University, earning a degree in petroleum engineering
- 12 with an emphasis in geology; he served his country as a captain in
- 13 the Army Corps of Engineers during World War II, after which he
- 14 joined a newly formed oil exploration firm as an engineering and
- 15 geology consultant; later, he became a partner in the firm, before
- 16 he took over the role of president in 1959; and
- WHEREAS, Under his forward-thinking leadership, the business
- 18 evolved into Mitchell Energy & Development Corporation, one of the
- 19 largest independent oil and gas producers in the nation; the
- 20 company merged with Devon Energy Corporation in 2002; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Mr. Mitchell was also responsible for one of the
- 22 most significant breakthroughs in the energy industry when he and
- 23 his staff discovered a way of extracting natural gas from shale
- 24 beds; this new method, now known as "fracking," created a massive

1 expansion in domestic natural gas supplies; and

2 WHEREAS, This dynamic Texan's drive to innovate led to success in other fields as well; in 1974, his venture into real 3 estate culminated in a 25,000-acre master-planned city north of 4 5 Houston, The Woodlands, considered an outstanding example of

environmentally conscious development; today, the community boasts 6

a population of 100,000 and an almost unprecedented amount of green

space in the form of greenbelts and forest preserves; and 8

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Mitchell and his wife, the late Cynthia Woods 10 Mitchell, shared a commitment to making a positive difference in the world, and together they established the Cynthia & George 11 Mitchell Foundation, which has pledged more than \$400 million in 12 support of education, the arts, and scientific research on clean 13 14 energy and sustainability; they also dedicated themselves to 15 restoring the historic Strand District in Mr. Mitchell's hometown of Galveston and played a key role in reviving the city's Mardi Gras 16 17 celebration, which now draws some 500,000 revelers annually; and

WHEREAS, A visionary entrepreneur in energy and land development, George Mitchell may reflect with great pride on his record of achievement as he joins an elite group of distinguished Texans who have received this prestigious award; now, therefore, be it
