16 WHEREAS, The organization also provides funding for the 17 Civitan International Research Center at the University of Alabama 18 at Birmingham and the Civitan-Sparks Clinics in Birmingham; the 19 center specializes in research into disorders such as autism, Down 20 syndrome, brain tumors, and epilepsy, and the clinics provide 21 children and families with diagnostic services, therapy, 22 counseling, and other resources; and

23 WHEREAS, Each day, Civitan International members devote 24 their talents and energies to serving the greater good and reaching
