12 WHEREAS, The awards conferred on this courageous young man 13 included the National Defense Service Medal, Pistol Marksmanship 14 Medal, and Global War on Terrorism Service Medal; and

WHEREAS, Exemplifying the highest ideals of the U.S. armed forces, Seaman Rast inspired others through his fortitude, tenacity, and dedication to his comrades-in-arms, and he has earned the lasting gratitude of every American for his valiant service in this nation's behalf; now, therefore, be it
