CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1           WHEREAS, Words cannot express the heartache felt at the loss  
2 of U.S. Army Sergeant Enrique Mondragon of The Colony, who died  
3 while bravely serving his country on December 24, 2012, at the age  
4 of 23; and

5           WHEREAS, Assigned to Headquarters and Headquarters  
6 Detachment, 173rd Special Troops Battalion, 173rd Airborne Brigade  
7 Combat Team, Bamberg, Germany, Sergeant Mondragon lost his life in  
8 Baraki Barak, Afghanistan; and

9           WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt of gratitude to this  
10 nation's servicemen and servicewomen, who make immeasurable  
11 sacrifices for their country and who risk their very lives in its  
12 behalf; and
