CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Words cannot express the heartache felt at the loss
2 of U.S. Army Chief Warrant Officer 2 Thalia S. Ramirez of San
3 Antonio, who died while bravely serving her country on September 5,
4 2012, at the age of 28; and

5 WHEREAS, Assigned to the 1st Squadron, 17th Cavalry Regiment,
6 82nd Combat Aviation Brigade, 82nd Airborne Division, Fort Bragg,
7 North Carolina, Chief Warrant Officer 2 Ramirez lost her life in
8 Logar Province, Afghanistan; and

9 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt of gratitude to this
10 nation's servicemen and servicewomen, who make immeasurable
11 sacrifices for their country and who risk their very lives in its
12 behalf; and
