CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Words cannot express the heartache felt at the loss
2 of U.S. Army Sergeant Jacob Molina of Houston, who died while
3 bravely serving his country on July 19, 2011, at the age of 27; and

4 WHEREAS, Assigned to the 2nd Battalion, 27th Infantry
5 Regiment, 3rd Brigade Combat Team, 25th Infantry Division,
6 Schofield Barracks, Hawaii, Sergeant Molina lost his life in Kunar
7 Province, Afghanistan; and

8 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt of gratitude to this
9 nation's servicemen and servicewomen, who make immeasurable
10 sacrifices for their country and who risk their very lives in its
11 behalf; and

12 WHEREAS, Exemplifying the highest ideals of the U.S. armed
13 forces, Jacob Molina inspired others with his fortitude, tenacity,
14 and courage; although his death leaves a void in the lives of his
15 loved ones, they will forever carry memories of this heroic Texan
16 close in their hearts; now, therefore, be it

18 hereby pay tribute to the life of Sergeant Jacob Molina and extend
19 sincere sympathy to all those who mourn his passing; and, be it

23 Representatives and Senate adjourn this day, they do so in memory of
24 U.S. Army Sergeant Jacob Molina.
