1 WHEREAS, Words cannot express the heartache felt at the loss
2 of U.S. Army Staff Sergeant Chauncy R. Mays of Cookville, who died
3 while bravely serving his country on February 28, 2011, at the age
4 of 25; and

5 WHEREAS, Assigned to the 63rd Explosive Ordnance Disposal
6 Battalion, 20th Support Command, Aberdeen Proving Ground,
7 Maryland, Staff Sergeant Mays lost his life in Wardak Province,
8 Afghanistan; and

9 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt of gratitude to this
10 nation's servicemen and servicewomen, who make immeasurable
11 sacrifices for their country and who risk their very lives in its
12 behalf; and
