4 WHEREAS, The bill contains technical errors that should be 5 corrected; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED by the 83rd Legislature of the State of Texas, That 7 the enrolling clerk of the house of representatives be instructed 8 to correct House Bill No. 5 as follows:

9 (1) In SECTION 16 of the bill, in amended Section 10 28.025(c-3), Education Code, strike "<u>(c-2)(1)(B)</u>" and substitute 11 "<u>(c-2)(1)(B)(ii)</u>".

12 (2) IN SECTION 77 of the bill, strike added Section13 130.008(f) and substitute the following:

(f) Except as provided by this section, a student may not enroll in more than three courses under this section at a junior college if the junior college does not have a service area that includes the student's high school. A student enrolled at an early college high school may enroll in a greater number of courses to the extent approved by the commissioner of education.
