HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 House Bill No. 5 has been adopted by the house of
2 representatives and the senate and is being prepared for
3 enrollment; and

4 WHEREAS, The bill contains technical errors that should be
5 corrected; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED by the 83rd Legislature of the State of Texas, That
7 the enrolling clerk of the house of representatives be instructed
8 to correct House Bill No. 5 as follows:

9 (1) In SECTION 16 of the bill, in amended Section
10 28.025(c-3), Education Code, strike "(c-2)(1)(B)" and substitute
11 "(c-2)(1)(B)(ii)".

12 (2) In SECTION 77 of the bill, strike added Section
13 130.008(f) and substitute the following:

14 (f) Except as provided by this section, a student may not
15 enroll in more than three courses under this section at a junior
16 college if the junior college does not have a service area that
17 includes the student's high school. A student enrolled at an early
18 college high school may enroll in a greater number of courses to the
19 extent approved by the commissioner of education.
