A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment concerning the maximum rate of
- 2 growth of appropriations.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 22, Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is
- 5 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) In no biennium shall the rate of growth of
- 8 appropriations from state tax revenues not dedicated by this
- 9 constitution exceed the lesser of the following rates:
- 10 <u>(1) the</u> estimated rate of growth of the state's
- 11 economy; and
- 12 (2) a rate equal to the sum of:
- 13 (A) the estimated biennial rate of growth of this
- 14 state's population; and
- 15 (B) the estimated biennial rate of monetary
- 16 inflation in this state.
- 17 (a-1) The legislature shall provide by general law
- 18 procedures to implement <u>Subsection</u> (a) of this section [this
- 19 subsection].
- 20 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 21 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2013.
- 22 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 23 proposition: "The constitutional amendment concerning the maximum
- 24 rate of growth of appropriations."
