## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment relating to the authority of
- 2 the governor to declare a moratorium on the execution of persons
- 3 convicted of capital offenses.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11, Article IV, Texas Constitution, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) The Governor may issue an order prohibiting the Texas
- 8 Department of Criminal Justice from performing executions on and
- 9 after the effective date of the order and until the order is
- 10 revoked, either by the Governor issuing the order or by a successor
- 11 to the Governor issuing the order.
- 12 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 13 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2013.
- 14 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 15 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 16 governor to declare a moratorium on the execution of persons
- 17 convicted of capital offenses."
