A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing a home-rule
- 2 municipality to provide in its charter the procedure to fill a

- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 11, Article XI, Texas Constitution, is
- 7 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (b) A municipality so providing a term exceeding two (2)
- 10 years but not exceeding four (4) years for any of its non-civil
- 11 service officers must elect all of the members of its governing body
- 12 by majority vote of the qualified voters in such municipality.
- (c) Any[, and any] vacancy or vacancies occurring on such
- 14 governing body shall not be filled by appointment but must be filled
- 15 by majority vote of the qualified voters at a special election
- 16 called for such purpose within one hundred and twenty (120) days
- 17 after such vacancy or vacancies occur except that the municipality
- 18 may provide by charter or charter amendment the procedure for
- 19 filling a vacancy occurring on its governing body for an unexpired
- 20 term of 12 months or less.
- 21 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 22 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2013.
- 23 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 24 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing a

- 1 home-rule municipality to provide in its charter the procedure to
