## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the foreclosure
- 2 of a lien on homestead property for costs incurred by a municipality
- 3 relating to a dangerous structure on the property.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 50, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (a-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (a) of this section, the
- 8 homestead of a family, or of a single adult person, is not protected
- 9 from forced sale for the payment of the costs incurred by a
- 10 municipality to vacate, secure, repair, remove, or demolish a
- 11 dangerous structure on the homestead property as authorized by the
- 12 <u>legislature by general law.</u>
- 13 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 14 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2013.
- 15 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 16 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 17 foreclosure of a lien on homestead property for the costs incurred
- 18 by a municipality to vacate, secure, repair, remove, or demolish a
- 19 dangerous structure on the property."
