A JOINT RESOLUTION

proposing a constitutional amendment providing for the election of
all county commissioners if the boundaries of commissioners
precincts change following a federal decennial census.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 18, Article V, Texas Constitution, is 6 amended by amending Subsections (b) and (d) and adding Subsection 7 (d-1) to read as follows:

(b) Each county shall, in the manner provided for justice of 8 9 the peace and constable precincts, be divided into four commissioners precincts in each of which there shall be elected by 10 11 the qualified voters thereof one County Commissioner, who shall 12 hold his office for four years and until his successor shall be elected and qualified, except as provided by Subsection (d-1) of 13 14 this section. The County Commissioners so chosen, with the County Judge as presiding officer, shall compose the County Commissioners 15 16 Court, which shall exercise such powers and jurisdiction over all county business, as is conferred by this Constitution and the laws 17 of the State, or as may be hereafter prescribed. 18

Except as provided by Subsection (d-1), when [When] the 19 (d) boundaries 20 of commissioners precincts are changed, each 21 commissioner in office on the effective date of the change, or elected to a term of office beginning on or after the effective date 22 23 of the change, shall serve in the precinct to which each was elected or appointed for the entire term to which each was elected or 24

1 appointed, even though the change in boundaries places the person's 2 residence outside the precinct for which he was elected or 3 appointed.

4 (d-1) All commissioners shall be elected in a year in which 5 the boundaries of a county's commissioners precincts are changed following the release of a federal decennial census. After 6 election, the commissioners elected shall be divided by lot into 7 8 two classes. The seats of the commissioners of the first class shall 9 be vacated at the expiration of the first two years, and those of the second class at the expiration of four years, so that one-half 10 of the commissioners shall be chosen biennially thereafter. 11

12 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be 13 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2013. 14 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the 15 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing for the 16 election of all county commissioners if the boundaries of 17 commissioners precincts change following a federal decennial 18 census."
