## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to require a person to be a
- 2 resident of this state for five years preceding the person's
- 3 election to the Texas House of Representatives.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 7, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 7. No person shall be a Representative  $[\tau]$  unless the
- 8 person is [he be] a citizen of the United States, and, at the time of
- 9 [his] election as a Representative, a qualified voter of this
- 10 State, and shall have been a resident of this State  $\underline{\text{five}}$  [two] years
- 11 next preceding  $\underline{\text{the}}$  [his] election, the last year thereof a resident
- 12 of the district for which  $\underline{\text{the person}}$  [ $\underline{\text{he}}$ ] shall be chosen, and shall
- 13 have attained the age of twenty-one years.
- 14 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 15 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2013.
- 16 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 17 proposition: "The constitutional amendment requiring a person to be
- 18 a resident of this state for five years preceding the person's
- 19 election to the Texas House of Representatives."
